Dear Sponsor,

This communication should help you with final details on the 2019 Rocky Mountain Baptist Youth Conference. We are very excited to see you and your teens very soon!

WHAT TO BRING

Clothing - Please see the online packing list and be prepared for adverse weather! The YMCA sits at 9000' elevation. This increases the chance of both sunburn and hypothermia depending on the day. Teens must have adequate layers. Snowstorms do occur at this time of year in the Colorado. www.rmbyc.org/files

Tic-Tac-Challenge - Also see the online item list for the Thursday night game. Teens will need these items after the evening service to help their team win the challenge. Please prepare your young people by encouraging them to pack for this activity. www.rmbyc.org/files

Cell Phones – Please be aware that we do have one activity involving cell phones. On Friday evening we have a special pizza party planned for juniors and seniors. You can allow them to compete in the competition as individuals with their own phones or as a group using your cell phone. Although service may be limited for some carriers, guest Wi-Fi is available throughout the YMCA property. Beyond this, we are asking teens to avoid playing music or videos on portable electronic devices during the conference.

Spending money – This year conference t-shirts are included, but teens may want additional cash for the following activities: climbing wall (\$10 hour), craft shop (\$10-15 most projects) or the gift shop.

After passing under the ranch-style YMCA entrance sign, take your second left onto Longhouse Way. The first building on your right (Hyde Chapel with bell tower) will be Check-In. Park in the lot across the road at the Eastside Lodges. Enter the main doors of Hyde.

At Check-In you will receive directions, room instructions, keys, schedule, booklets, meal wristband, and t-shirt vouchers. You will receive two keys per room. Please give these to responsible individuals.

The first required event after Check-In is Orientation at 8pm in Hyde Chapel. Until that time, you will be free to move into your rooms, eat supper (5-7:30pm) and enjoy free time activities such as open gym, game room, mini golf, etc. Please be sure that all your teens are seated in Hyde Chapel by 8pm!
